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Hebrew Insert

1. Download this PDF booklet for the Hebrew text.
2. Print on 8.5" x 14" paper (two-sides)
3. Fold the page in half and trim at the dotted line.
4. Store the booklet under the Haggadah's front flap.
5. Practice reading Hebrew!

Haggadah Cards

1. Print the eleven pages, glue to poster board & cut into forty-four picture cards.
2. Scatter the cards on the raft around a box large enough to hold all cards.
3. Tell the crew to search for clues in the story. Ask them to find the cards when they see its picture in the book.
4. The finder holds up the matching card. When the reader turns the page, the card goes into the box.
5. Every card must be stowed before Haggadah Regatta can sail home.

Stomp! Sign

Give the signs to timekeepers to signal when to stomp and when to stop stomping.

Ah'feeKOHmehn Cards

Hide one card in advance of the reading. When the story turns to matzahs, show the crew what to look for later in the seder.

Seder Placemats

Decorate the placemats with markers & laminate. Talk about the characters and ask why they are important to the seder.
